SwissABILITY collaborates with the local association SLASA to realize the construction of a new orthopedic centre in the Port Loko District, Sierra Leone, so that people with disabilities in the region, including many survivors of the civil war, can access advanced orthopedic and physiotherapy services at subsidized prices.

Over the course of the three-year project, in particular, the provision of rehabilitative services will be ensured for at least 600 users

The project includes:

- Construction of an orthopedic centre powered by solar panels.
- Supply of machinery and materials for the manufacture of prostheses and orthoses.
